

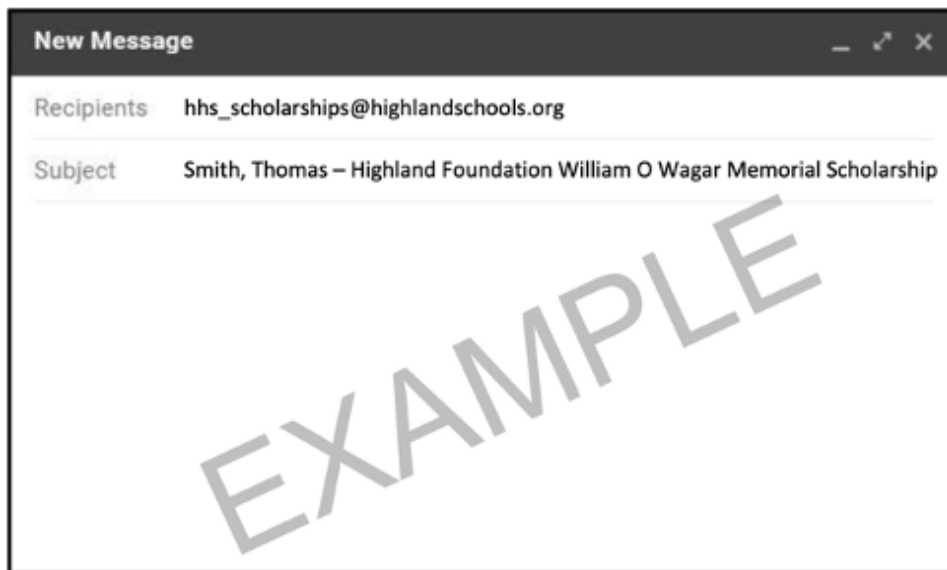

Instructions for Scholarship Submission – Please read the following carefully

Due Date – Applications must be submitted by March 15th, 2024.

1. Please read the scholarship description as well as the eligibility criteria before filling out the scholarship application. We encourage you to apply for all scholarships where you meet the eligibility requirements. Please complete the scholarship application in its entirety. If sections are missing, the application will not be accepted.
2. Each scholarship must be emailed as one PDF file to hhs_scholarships@highlandschools.org. Include the following information in the subject line of the email (example below)
 - Your Last Name
 - Your First Name
 - Name of the scholarship



3. If you are applying for multiple scholarships, please send each one in a separate email.
4. If a transcript is required, the counseling department will attach it to your submission once it is received.
5. If a letter of recommendation from a staff member within Highland High School is required, please ask the recommender to scan and submit separately to hhs_scholarships@highlandschools.org.
6. If an outside recommendation letter is requested, it must be attached as part of your scholarship application.
7. Scan and submit your completed application to hhs_scholarships@highlandschools.org.

4. Pursuing 4-year college degree in business and/or music
5. Participation in a Highland Foundation Scholarship Committee Interview

Important - Submit this scholarship application, with all blanks appropriately completed, according to the above instructions.

Scholarship Renewal:

Chorba Family "Give Where You Live" Scholarship Awards are eligible for renewal in the year subsequent to the initial award, provided the scholarship recipient remains in contact with The Highland Foundation for Educational Excellence. Renewal eligibility is determined by a Scholarship Selection Committee review process that occurs at the end of the spring term for those students who:

1. Graduated Highland High School and received initial Chorba Family Scholarship funding the previous year;
2. Maintain a 3.0 or higher GPA and achieve sufficient academic credits to advance to the next class year (i.e., second year students must be considered sophomores or higher);
3. Submit a letter to The Highland Foundation for Educational Excellence (3880 Ridge Rd., Medina, OH 44256) requesting a renewal by January 1 of their freshman college year; and
4. Include a transcript or report of their hours completed for the year and overall cumulative GPA at the institution where the student received funding with the letter.

Applications will be reviewed by the Highland Foundation Scholarship Committee. The scholarship recipient will be recognized with a \$1,981 Chorba Family "Give Where You Live" Scholarship at the annual HHS Senior Awards assembly. Renewal Awards must be requested, will be \$1,985, and will be mailed upon determination and verification
